Meeting Minutes December 21, 2022

Members present: Chairman David Jakubowski, Ed Windecker, Jim Trowbridge

David called the meeting to order at 6:04 PM.

Jim/ David MOVED TO APPROVE THE 10-19-22 minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

David reported that his efforts to schedule field trips to nearby transfer stations met with little success. Discussion suggested that 1st Selectman Deb Richards could help facilitate setting up these visits. The committee decided not to visit the Eastford transfer station because members are familiar with its layout and use.

David distributed the Annual Municipal Recycling Report for FY 2021-2022, the Municipal Transfer Station Quarterly Report for Jul-Sep of 2022, and the Household Hazardous Waste Facility Schedule for 2023, which includes a list of acceptable materials.

The Committee reviewed the MidNEROC Summary of Contractor Listings for 2022-2023, a Casella notification of increased pricing for MSW and bulky waste, and the scrap metal agreement with Connecticut Scrap.

Jim reported that, at the 12-15-22 MidNEROC meeting, CT DEEP asked for support for upcoming Extended Producer Responsibility legislation regarding the disposal of used packaging and used tires. Jim will inform the 1st Selectman of this opportunity.

As a transfer station attendant, Ed provided the Committee with valuable detail and perspective from "inside the operation."

David initiated a discussion about gated access to the Transfer Station. For instance, licence plate reading technology could be used to allow or deny access.

As the need arises, David will apprise the 1st Selectman of the suggestions and/ or recommendations arising from Committee discussions.

The Committee read a letter from Mike Schultz regarding Transfer Station related topics.
